Tuition Raffle Rules & Regulations

- 5. Winner must sign and submit Form W-9 prior to receiving tuition credit. The IRS considers raffle winnings as income, all tax rules apply. Raffle tickets are NOT tax deductible as a charitable contribution. You may not rely on any representation by MCA as tax or legal advice.
- 6. One winning ticket will be drawn on the 6th of April, 2017 at the Metro Dinner & Auction. Winner does not have to be present to win.
- 7. Tuition credit cannot be redeemed for cash and is good only for the 2017-2018 school year. If Winner has already paid an enrollment deposit, it will be refunded.
