



MASKING POLICY

FOR STUDENTS, PARENTS, EMPLOYEES AND VISITORS

- 1 MASK/FACE COVERING REQUIREMENTS:** All individuals are required to wear masks, buffs, or face shields in common spaces, large groups, and during transitions. Individuals may choose which face covering (e.g. mask, buff, etc.) to wear and are permitted to wear them all of the time.

Mask/Face Coverings should be comfortable and fit snugly to one's face and chin, allowing for breathing without restriction. Masks/face coverings are to be made of tightly woven fabric material and include at least 2 layers of fabric, secured by ties or ear loops, able to be laundered, and should align with Metro's free dress guidelines.

N95's and disposable surgical masks are acceptable if used properly and changed daily. N95's or masks with valves are not permitted.

- 2 STUDENTS:** Students P3 - 12th grades will need to wear a mask to school every day and have it with them at all times. While masks are not required to be worn in physically distanced spaces, they should be readily available to use when needed.

ALL: All students, employees, coaches, parents, visitors, vendors, etc. must be wearing a mask before exiting their cars and before entering the facilities.

- 3 FACE COVERINGS:** Face Coverings (e.g. mask, buff, and/or face shields) are required for faculty, staff, coaches, visitors, vendors, etc. during times of transition and when physical distancing protocols cannot be observed. A variety of face coverings will be available via Lands' End, Patriot Wearhouse, or your choice of provider. Metro will provide emergency provisions if needed.
