- Teachers will provide clear communication on deadlines for assignments.
- Some teachers may also use internet tools, such as Zoom, YouTube, or others to provide additional instructional support.
- Flexibility and communication will be vital to this process. Students need to communicate any challenges they are experiencing with completing their assignments to their teachers.
- Students will not have daily meetings with their classes with this method of instruction, although some teachers may at times schedule online class meetings.
- Teachers will be available to answer questions during normal school hours.
