



REMOTE LEARNING PROTOCOL FAQ'S

QUESTION 1:

Why are we implementing a Remote Learning Protocol (RLP)?

We value both safety and learning, and we think you do, too!

QUESTION 2:

Will the RLP days have to be “made up”?

No. Since nearly (if not all) Oklahoma schools are impacted, we will not add days to the school calendar to “make up” the RLP days.

QUESTION 3:

My child does not have access to a computer and/or the Internet. How will he/she do online work?

Please let us know as soon as possible if this is a challenge for you.

QUESTION 4:

When are assignments due?

Teachers will communicate this information to you.

QUESTION 5:

How long should it take for my child to complete the RLP assignments?

Each student will work at his/her own pace, so the time required to complete the work will vary; however, the requested work is a strategic minimum.

QUESTION 6:

Am I expected to teach my child new content while he/she is working on RLP assignments?

No, as per usual teachers will take the lead on introducing new content and concepts.

QUESTION 7:

What if my child has questions about the RLP work assignments or trouble while he/she is completing the work?
